

## Durham Crematorium – Fees and Charges With effect from April 2021

- Adult cremation (over 18 years) - £750
- Discounted times (9.00am or 9.30 if all other slots are full) - £670
- Saturday morning cremations - £1105
- Direct cremation (unattended – 8.00am or 8.15am) - £530
- Direct cremation (attended – 8.30am) - £670

The adult cremations above all include the medical referee fee and an ashes box.

- Child up to one month (including stillborn) - free of charge
- Child over one month and not exceeding 18 years - free of charge
- NVF (24 weeks gestation or less) (9.00am or 9.30 only) - free of charge
- Body parts - £9

The child cremations above will be subject to the medical referee fee of £30.

- Use of chapel for service only (9.00am, 9.30, 3.00pm or 3.30) - £200
- Use of chapel for service only (Between 10am and 2.30) - £600
- Additional half hour service (Double slot) - £100
- Strewing of cremated remains from other crematoria - £50
- Cancellation (less than 48 hours' notice) - £250
- Overrun exceeding 10 minutes - £50
- Use of organ (crematorium fee) - £5
- Organist (payable to organist) - £30
- DVD or USB recording of service - (£40 + VAT) £48
- CD recording of service - (£40 + VAT) £48
- Additional copies - (£23.34 + VAT) £28
- Webcast of a service - (£40 + VAT) £48
- Visual tribute (admin fee) - £15 + VAT

(If a second segment is required, that will be subject to an additional - £5 + VAT admin fee)

- Visual tribute (per photograph) - £3 + VAT
- Visual tribute (per minute of video) - £6 + VAT
- DVD copy of visual tribute - (£18 + VAT) £21.60
- Scatter tube - £12
- Small scatter tube - £6
- Mini scatter tube - £3
- Additional urn box - £10

Other urn prices/brochure are available on request from office.

The standard cremation fee includes use of chapel for 20 minutes and scattering of remains on the Garden of Remembrance OR an ashes box with the cremation.
